Skip Barber's auto racing career began in 1959, when he won his first race while attending Harvard on a full scholarship. He's come a long way, gaining renown as a driver; as the founder and developer of the largest, most respected racing and high performance driving school in the world; and as the initiator of the first real "ladder system" to enable gifted young American drivers to ascend to the top echelons of racing.

He also is the owner who made Lime Rock Park in Lakeville, Connecticut the beautiful circuit it is today. Now the park's sole owner, his latest passion is the new Club at Lime Rock Park, an

exclusive motor sports club for automotive enthusiasts.

Additionally, he is a recognized collector and connoisseur of vintage sports cars, examples of which can be seen during the park's public events. Major races during the 2008 season at Lime Rock include the Grand-Am GT Classic on Memorial Day weekend (May 23-26), the American Le Mans Northeast Grand Prix on July 11-12 and the Rolex Vintage Festival Labor Day Weekend (August 29 through September 1.)
